**Nominations for the Dr. George B. Brooks
Social Justice/Human Rights Award
to be awarded at the March 11, 2011 Stated
Presbytery Meeting**

The Social Justice & Peacemaking Committee invites nominations for the **Dr. George B. Brooks Award**. Nominations for this annual award can be made by a church session, a committee of the Presbytery, or two members of any of the churches in our Presbytery. The recipient will be awarded \$500 by the committee **to be donated to a non-profit justice and/or peacemaking organization of the recipient's choice.**

Criteria for the Award include the following:

- A. Dedication to social justice, human rights, and peacemaking demonstrated by specific accomplishments made in Arizona – 60 points.
- B. Identifiable benefits to individuals and community, church, or state by that person's dedication – 30 points.
- C. At least one statement affirming the evidence of that commitment from a person or agency impacted by the nominee – 10 points.

The nominee must be a member of a congregation in the Presbytery of the Grand Canyon or a continuing member of the Presbytery, may not be a current member of the SJ&P Committee, and must not have been a member of the SJ&P Committee for at least one year. Individuals nominated previously may be nominated again.
