Rev. Michael Lindvall is pastor of The Brick Presbyterian Church in New York City. He was raised in small-town Minnesota and the Upper Peninsula of Michigan. A graduate of the University of Wisconsin-Oshkosh and Princeton Theological Seminary, he has previously served as pastor to congregations in Ann Arbor, Michigan and Northport, Long Island. Lindvall is known among Presbyterians as a writer whose essays, book reviews, sermons and fiction appear in a variety of church-related and secular periodicals. He has written two novels, *The Good News from North Haven*, and *Leaving North Haven*, both have been published by Crossroad/ Carlisle Books. A volume of accessible theology entitled *The Christian Life: A Geography of God*, was recently released by Geneva Press.

This week is made possible through a grant from the General Assembly Council to the Synod of the Southwest (SSW) and is open to all pastors serving within the bounds of SSW. Preference will be given to those who are actively serving congregations. Registration is limited to 60 participants.
