

Biographical Information for Paul Rooker, Treasurer Elect

Paul Rooker is a member of Pinnacle Presbyterian Church, joining that congregation in 2002. He was ordained an Elder in Faith Presbyterian, LaVista, NE in 1982. While in Nebraska, he served as both a deacon and elder, and was the church building fund treasurer for several years. He was previously ordained a deacon at Memorial Presbyterian Church, Montgomery, AL.
