**Biography**

I was born in Andong, Kyung-Buk, South Korea on February 9, 1944. My father was a pastor when the Korean War was occurring. He was honored as a martyr. He was a member of the Korea Independence Movement under Japanese Control. Because of that, he lived 3 ½ years in jail. My mother had no formal education; however she evangelized my father and his whole family. Consequently, our whole family became Christians; and especially my father became a famous Christian leader in Korean history.

I have three older brothers who are pastor and elder in the Korean Church. My two nephews are pastors, and one of my nephews is currently the most famous pastor for a young generation. His own serving church has over 25,000 attendees (mostly young people) every Sunday.

I graduated Yonsei University in Seoul and came to the US to get my MA degree from Pittsburgh Seminary and M.Div. from Louisville Seminary and was ordained as a Minister of Word and Sacrament. I served Lutheran Hospital of Indiana as a Chaplain and Upper Valley Medical Center, Troy, Ohio as a Chaplain. I served Westminster Presbyterian Church, Fort Wayne, Indiana in a pastoral internship. I served Racial Ethnic Concerns Committee and Representation Committee in the Synod of Lincoln Trails and in the Whitewater Valley Presbytery. I served the Women's Concerns Committee for many years. I translated "Bible Study Textbook, Crisis As Opportunity" to Koreans. I was a president of Asian-American Community, Inc., Fort Wayne, Indiana.

I started a new Korean Congregation at Church of the Master in Mesa, Arizona, March 2002. I served the Korean Church of Long Island, Port Washington, New York as a Co-Interim Pastor with my husband, Joseph Doh, from February – November 2008. I am still continuing serving as a Minister of Word and Sacrament in daily life, through calling, visiting, counseling, praying, teaching, etc. God is still working for me to accomplish God's purpose. I am praying to participate in God's direction and leadership. I know that God is still working with me in any moment as his special and unique instrument. Momentum is my spot in everyday life. Every moment is meaningful for me. I translated the book of "Preaching Christian Doctrine" by Dr. William Carl, Jr., into Korean and it is in the process of being published at Durano Publishing Co., in Korea.

My husband and I have three children. Catherine, 40 years old, has two children with her husband, John. James married last year and has a happy family; and Esther has one son with her husband who is teaching New Testament at Luther College, Iowa.

The life of Light through Jesus Christ gives me great satisfaction and happiness in my life journey right now. I am grateful and peaceful to see that God's guiding and leading of my life journey have been unconditionally given and constantly dwelled with me through all the way. To know God is amazing and mysterious is a great gift as well as secret treasure.
